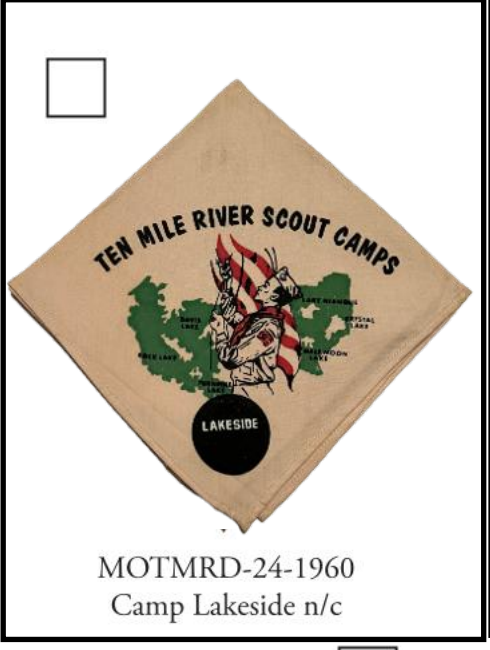
1960 Overprint Series made from 1959 Exposition neckerchiefs

In 1959 a large Scouting Exposition was held by Greater New York Councils. Among the items for resale were tan neckerchiefs and pink and white ladies scarfs and white tee shirts. At the end of the season, there were a large number of the neckerchiefs left in inventory. Realizing dated neckerchiefs would not be a popular sales item a year later, an idea was developed to silkscreen black circles over all the neckerchiefs obscuring the event and date. Once dry they were apporioned to the various 11 operating camps on the TMR Scout Reservation with a white stencil of the name of that camp over the black circle. Shown are 10 of the 11 known neckerchiefs and it is reasonable to assume there is also a Davis Lake which we did not have an image of. It is unlikely there was a Headquarters overprint since the old HQ did not have a large Main Trading Post like the new Headquarters and therefore was rarely, if ever, a destination for hiking troops to visit. There would have only been staff at HQ who had their own unique staff neckerchiefs and no scouts so no purpose to have such a neckerchief. When the Tower of Friendship Jacket patches were ordered the person doing the ordering forgot to tell the manufacturer what order the center stones were meant to be in. The manufacturer was not going to wait to complete the order and get these off his machine so he made 1/3 of them from top to bottom- gray-blue-green stones blue-green-gray stones, green-gray-blue stones. There is no meaning to the order of these stones on these patches and each had an equal number made and are of equal value. A few outliers have been found: Blue-gray-green, Gray-blue-gray, Green-blue-green.
