The Lenape program at Camp Kunatah's Lenape Village provided Scouts and Scouters with an opportunity to learn about and live as the Lenape Indians did in the Delaware Valley. The program included Native American lore and crafts, story telling, group games, advanced wilderness skills, adventure activities, special hikes and programs designed around a Native American theme. It existed from 1989-1993 but probably started earlier and ended later. In 1990, the North Wind Escape program combined with the Lenape program to offer outdoor skills the first American settlers developed. All programs taught self-confidence, cooperation with the environment and teamwork through cooperative (initiative) games and challenges.

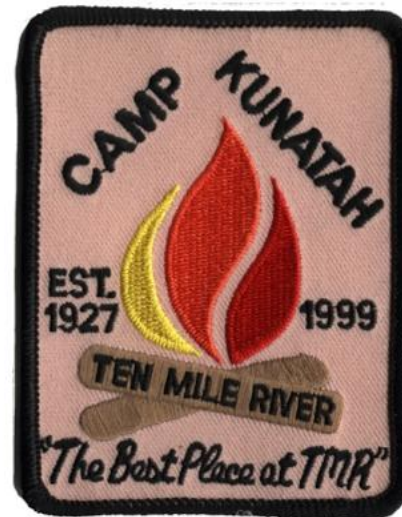

Food, lodging and bus transportation were included.

Outpost Camps

In 1965, TMR Program Director John Duffy began the Outpost Camp program. Patterned after Philmont Scout Ranch, the eleven TMR camps were each responsible for staffing a nearby Outpost Camp. Scouts participated in an afternoon program, cooked their own meals and slept overnight at the camp. Among these were canoeing, archery, survival, fishing, sailing and Indian-lore camps. Less popular Outpost Camps dropped over the years and by 1973 only five remained. A 6” round backpatch was produced for each of them.

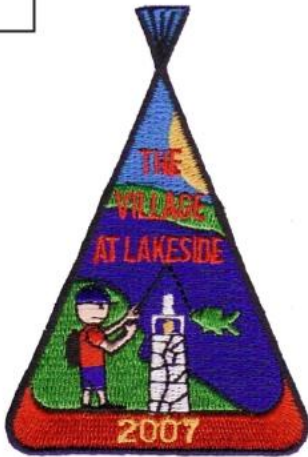

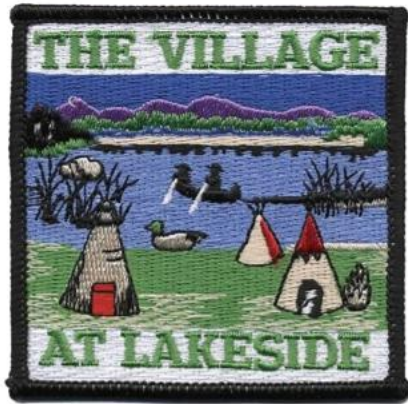
An outpost camp created by Ira Nagel in 1997 at old Camp Lakeside. It featured farm animals, fishing, games, barbecues and an Indian Village.

TMR Trek/High Adventure

Beginning in 1992, TMR offered the TMR High Adventure Trek as an alternative to traditional week-long resident camp.
