The Museum, at Headquarters Camp, Ten Mile River Scout Camps is dedicated to preserving the history and artifacts of the Ten Mile River Scout Camps and the Upper Delaware River Valley. It consists of the three-room *Museum Building* and three buildings from former T.M.R. camps: *The Camp Kernochan Blockhouse*, *the Cayuga/Kotohke Cabin* and the *Jerry Reimer/Camp Kunatah Trading Post*.

Founded in 1997 and repeatedly expanded, the Museum is the repository of the camp memorabilia and memories of countless Scouts who camped at T.M.R. since 1927. While T.M.R. has changed over the years, the Museum's collection of memorabilia, photos,



videos and artifacts from T.M.R.'s history makes it, in a sense, timeless.

The Ten Mile River Scout Museum has been successful in large part due to the strong support by T.M.R. Alumni and other members of the N.Y.C. Scouting community.



Ten Mile River Wall of Fame

Do you want to recognize some individual, group or organization for their contributions to the Ten Mile River Scout Camps and/or New York City Scouting? A custom-engraved tile on the T.M.R. Wall of Fame might be right for you.

The T.M.R. Wall of Fame is located at the Ten Mile River Scout Museum. It consists of two parts:

T.M.R. Monument - A monument to all 20 T.M.R. camps that operated since 1928. Each tile includes the camp name. Unit and Division names, years of operation and traditional camp logo. On the reverse side is an engraved T.M.R. Map. depicting all of the T.M.R. camps, trails and local landmarks.



Memorial Wall – Personalized, engraved tiles recognizing some individual, group or organization for their contributions to the Ten Mile River Scout Camps and/or New York City Scouting.

Tiles are available in a variety of sizes, colors and materials. Laser-engraved granite tiles can depict photos, line art and even small lettering. Camera-ready art is not required. We will work with you to design your tile according to your specifications.

Tiles must be ordered by June 1st of each year to be publically recognized at the T.M.R. Alumni Day later that summer. Profits from tile sales support the Ten Mile River Scout Camps and the Ten Mile River Scout Museum.

TILE DESCRIPTIONS

"BRICK" Tile

- Brick-shaped, 7 1/2" x 3 5/8" earthen-colored tile.
- 2-3 lines engraved lettering.
- Maximum 18 letters & spaces per line.
- Black paint improves detail.
- Price: \$125.



"SQUARE" Tile

- Square, 7 1/2" x 7 1/2" earthen-colored
- 1-5 lines engraved lettering.
- Maximum 18 letters & spaces per line.
- Black paint improves detail.
- Price: \$250.



"GRAY GRANITE" Tile

- Square, 12" x 12" polished black granite laser-engraved tile.
- Text and logo appears as polished black granite against gray laser-engraved background.
- Laser-engraving permits exact duplication of camera-ready art. including logos and small lettering.
- No photos.
- Price: \$500.

"BLACK GRANITE" Tile

- Square, black polished 12" x 12" black granite laser-engraved tile.
- Laser-engraving permits exact duplication of camera-ready art, including logos, photos and small letterina.
- Price: \$1,000.
