

Ten Mile River Scout Museum reopens

NARROWSBURG, NY — The Ten Mile River Scout Museum, located on the grounds of Ten Mile River Scout Camps' headquarters at 1481 County Road 26, is open for the summer season as of July 13. All visits should be scheduled by calling 845/252-2063.

The museum will be open the following hours: Tuesday to Friday, 9 a.m. to 12 p.m., 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 9 p.m.; Saturday, 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.; and Sunday, 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

If people wish to visit outside the set hours, contact the museum to schedule an appointment. Information about schedule changes and events will be posted on the museum's website, www.tmrmuseum.org.

The newest exhibit, "The Geology of the Ten Mile River Scout Camps," is representative of the entire Upper Delaware River Valley. It includes a video, "Upper Delaware River Resource Mapping," from a presentation that New York State Museum and geological survey scientist James Leone delivered to the Upper Delaware Council, summarizing the findings of a contractual project with the National Park Service to take samples and map the geological features of the Upper Delaware Scenic and Recreational River valley on the New York side.
